


This Quick Reference Card explains the minimum hardware and software requirements you need to obtain and manage your Standard NAP User Account and NAP Password, and to access and use ROSS. Review these requirements whenever you access ROSS on a new computer, such as a rental computer or other non-FS agency computer.

ROSS Recommended Hardware

- ✓ Intel (or compatible) Processor I3 or better.
- ✓ 4 GB of memory or better.
- ✓ Wired or Wireless Network (802.11 g/n or NIC 10/100/1000).
- ✓ 256 MB Video Card or better.
- ✓ Hard Drive: 5 GB of Free Space for ROSS install and 100 MB of free space for Internet Explorer Caching.

To disable protected mode in Internet Explorer

- 1 Start **Internet Explorer**, click the **Tools** drop-down arrow, and then click **Internet Options**.
- 2 On the **Internet Options** dialog box, click the **Security** tab, and then click to clear the **Enable Protected Mode** check box.
- 3 Click **Apply** and then click **OK**



ROSS and NAP Recommended Software

Operating System

- ✓ Windows 7 (minimum 32 bit; 64 bit preferred).
- ✓ Compatible with Windows XP.

Browser

- ✓ Internet Explorer, version 8 or greater.

NAP will not work with versions before IE 8.

Adobe Flash Player

- ✓ NAP requires Adobe Flash Player, version 11 or greater.


To determine if Adobe Flash Player is installed and its version number

- A Start your Internet browser, and then type the following in the **Address bar**, type

- B Review the **Version Information** box.
