

Connecting Client Machines to e-ISuite on Forest Service Networks

Question:

How does a client machine connect to the Site Server on a Forest Service Network?

Solution:

Normally e-ISuite Site is configured to accept incoming HTTP Requests on Port 80, but the Forest Service recently instituted a firewall policy change that blocks the use of Port 80 on Forest Service networks.

Accordingly, e-ISuite Site Version 1.2 has been modified to accept HTTP Requests on either Port 80 or Port 59123, and the Forest Service has granted an exception for the use of Port 59123 on Forest Service networks. Below are the URL requirements for e-ISuite on Forest Service Networks:

Server – Users working on a server machine on the Forest Service network can connect to localhost as usual at:

<http://localhost/isuite/fx/welcome.html#>

Client – To access e-ISuite from a client machine on the Forest Service network, the user must specify Port 59123 in their URL as follows:

<http://ServerIPAddress:59123/isuite/fx/welcome.html#>
