Summary of changes made to IROC, Tuesday February 22, 2022

Catalog Upgrade:

- The IROC Catalog upgrade has been a coordinated effort over several months with associated NWCG committees and integrated applications to review and update the catalog to meet NWCG standards and be more appropriate for the current ordering environment. Please review the Memo to NCSC (National Coordination System Committee) which communicates the IROC Resource Ordering Catalog Revision and summary of changes for 2022 as well as the list of Catalog changes linked on the IROC Website:

- New 4-letter mnemonic Item Codes have been implemented for all Aircraft, Crew, Equipment, Overhead Groups and Non-NFES Supply Catalog Item qualifications.
 - The Item Codes have replaced the Category-Catalog Item prefixes for resource Operational Names.
 - For example: Airtanker, Type - T-10 has become LATI - T-10.
 - Users can type the Item Code or Catalog Item in the Catalog Item field when searching for an item to create new Requests.
- Catalog Items identified to no longer be used will be Inactivated by the end of May allowing Centers time to attach new or other appropriate Catalog Item qualifications to resources.
- E-ISuite will be implementing the new Catalog updates and Items Codes with their 2.1.2 Spring Release tentatively scheduled for April 18, 2022.
- CALFIRE CAD, HEMS and InciNET systems will be adopting the new Catalog and Items Code updates in those respective systems as well in the coming days and weeks. HEMS and InciNet will implement February 25, 2022, and CAD in 2 weeks.

Requests:

- Closed the Roster side door placing options. When a center receives a rostered subordinate request, users can only Fill, Send Back or UTF the request now. Previously users could also Place these requests Up, Down or Direct.
- Mobilization Travel from Parent can now be unchecked on the initial travel modal.
 - When filling a request with a resource that needs travel, user can view and uncheck the 'Mobilization Travel from Parent' box on the initial travel modal in portal, allowing for setting travel for that resource as part of the initial fill process.

- IROC will now save a static version of resource Operational Name at the time of assignment using the appropriate Catalog Item Code qualification prefix. Previously if a resource was assigned or reassigned with a different qualification than the resource's primary Catalog Item qualification the Operational Name was not updated correctly to the Catalog Item prefix at the time of assignment.
 - The static Operational Name is key record keeping for resources with multiple quals (i.e., Aircraft and Equipment) request assignment history.

Resources:

- Applied a Hot Fix to export the appropriate Operational Name for a non-Overhead responder resource when the resource's primary qualification was updated, or Assignment Qualification was updated. Previously these updates were not exporting to IRWIN.

Additional Items of Note ----

- IQCS responders that go on long term (30-day or more) details and the home unit wants to retain certification management of the responder's qualifications are to be temporarily transferred within IQCS, that is the Authoritative Data Source (ADS). All changes are made in IQCS, the responder will show up under the temporary dispatch center in IROC.
