

INTERMEDIATE UNIT 5 SCENARIO (A)

REQUEST STATUS

Request Status screen.

1. The FMO calls and asks you to cancel the reassignment of the 2 Firefighters (FFT2) from the Ditch Incident to the Aspen Incident, and to put them back on the Ditch Incident (“Previous Request” radio button).
2. Two of the Firefighters (FFT2) on an engine on the Aspen Incident (look for the Engine with the * in the “G” column) are being swapped out and need to have replacements by 0800 tomorrow morning. Create these two new subordinate requests.

Pending Request screen.

3. On the Pending Request screen for the Aspen Incident, look under “E” in the “Request #” field. Make sure the 2 Firefighter (FFT2) requests you just created are there.

Request Status screen.

4. The external dispatch office that filled one of your Type 3 Engines on the Aspen Incident calls back with some additional information. One by one highlight the **Filled** Type 3 Engines, click the “Action” button, and look for the “Edit External Resource” option on the bottom of the pop-up menu. The external dispatch office gives you the license plate number of the engine and the names of the firefighters coming with it. Enter the license plate number (*MT 2T 29611*) in the “Alternate Name” field. Then click “Edit Manifest” and create a manifest for the crew. Create 1 Engine Operator (ENOP) and 2 Firefighters (FFT2). Make up some Names and a Home Unit / Contact for the manifest.
5. The weather has changed and there is no need to swap out the 2 Firefighters on the Engine above because they will all be released soon. After checking the “Show Subordinate Requests” box, Cancel the 2 Firefighters that are Pending on the Engine with the * in the “G” column.
