e-ISuite Enterprise Version 1.1.1.1 (No Installation Necessary)

The e-ISuite Enterprise system will be updated concurrently with the release of the e-ISuite Site Patch.

Important Things to Know Prior to Installing e-ISuite Site 1.1.1.1 Patch

- Only apply this patch to e-ISuite Version 1.1.1 Production.
- Backup all databases before applying the patch.
- Close all browser windows and ensure there are no active connections to the e-ISuite Server.
- System Administrative privileges **are** required to install this patch.
Note: To apply this patch, download the file and right-click on the file and choose either Run as Administrator or Run Elevated (USFS).
- The version will not be updated with this patch. A message stating "Patch 1 to 1.1.1 Applied" will display on the home page near the server date. This will be confirmation that the patch is installed. It may be necessary to Refresh or Clear your Browser Cache before the message will display.
