Description: The primary focus of this release is to address performance issues and Training Specialist Module issues. Several urgent defects were also addressed.

Important Things to Know Prior to Installing e-ISuite Site Version 1.2.3

- **YOU MUST UNINSTALL** all previous versions of e-ISuite Site.

- System Requirements
 - Windows 7 Professional or Windows 2008/2012 Server
Will install and run on Windows 10, but is not an officially supported operating system

 - No competing http Services (Tomcat6 will provide web services on server machine)
- Browser Requirements
 - Internet Explorer 11 Officially Supported
 - Pop-up Blockers Turned Off
 - Latest Adobe Flash Installed
- System Administrative privileges **are** required to install the application.
Note: To install, download the file and right-click on the installer file and choose either Run as Administrator or Run Elevated (USFS).

e-ISuite Site Version 1.2.3 Installation Instructions When Previous Version is Installed

Step 1: Copy all the files in the NWCG-BACKUPS folder from C:\ProgramData\e-ISuite to another location such as a USB Drive or External Hard Drive. By default, e-ISuite backups are stored in the following directory: C:\ProgramData\e-ISuite\NWCG-Backups

Note: Users should copy everything in that directory to a different location (either an external hard drive, a USB drive, or another location on their machine)

Step 2: Uninstall the current version of e-ISuite. The safest way to uninstall e-ISuite is to use the e-ISuite uninstaller in the start menu under Start Menu > All Programs > e-ISuite. Users must run that uninstaller by right-clicking on Uninstall e-ISuite Site and picking either Run Elevated (USFS Users) or Run As Administrator (all other users).

Step 3: Users will be required to reboot their systems after uninstalling e-ISuite.


Step 4: (Recommended, but not Required) After the system reboots, users need to delete the e-ISuite folder from C:\ProgramData. Note that elevated privileges are required to delete items from C:\ProgramData - either Run Elevated Privileges for USFS Users or Administrator Privileges for other users.

Note: The C:\ProgramData folder may not be visible if users have their folder settings set to not show hidden files and folders. If it is not visible, users can temporarily change their Folder Settings to show hidden files and folders under the Control Panel > Appearance and Personalization > Folder Options)

For an USFS computer select “Start”, in the “Search programs and files” box, type “Windows Explorer”.



“Windows Explorer” should show up under Programs. Right-click on “Windows Explorer” and select “Run Elevated”.



A PowerBroker window will display, type “Remove e-ISuite folder from C:\ProgramData”. With the elevated permissions delete the e-ISuite folder from C:\ProgramData.

- **Step 5:** After deleting the e-ISuite folder from C:\ProgramData, users may proceed with the installation of e-ISuite Site 1.2.3.
