



## e-ISuite 1.2.4 Patch 4 Release Notes

**Date:** August 20, 2018  
**Version:** Apply to Site Version 1.2.4

### Description:

The purpose of Patch 4 is to correct an issue with running cost reports and correct issues with the Financial Export.

### Important Things to Know Prior to Installing e-ISuite Site 1.2.4 Patch 4

- Only apply this patch to e-ISuite Version 1.2.4 Production. This patch contains all the fixes addressed in Patches 1-3, as well as those described above.
- If you have already installed previous patches, you may just apply this patch to your Site installation without the need to uninstall/reinstall e-ISuite. If you have not installed any previous patches, you may just install this Patch 4.
- Backup all databases before applying the patch.
- Close all browser windows and ensure there are no active connections to the e-ISuite Server.
- System Administrative privileges **are** required to install this patch. See detailed instructions below.
- The version will not be updated with this patch. A message stating "(Patch 4 to 1.2.4 Applied)" will display on the Home Page near the server date. This will be confirmation that the patch is installed. It may be necessary to Refresh or Clear your Browser Cache before the message will display. ### Steps for Installation

1. Download the Site 1.2.4 Patch 4 from the Site Download page on the e-ISuite Webpage:

2. To install the patch, right-click on the file and choose either Run as Administrator or Run Elevated (USFS).



3. A DOS window will popup showing the progress of the installation for the Patch.

Depending on the computer hardware this process could take a few minutes. When the DOS Window goes away the patch installation has completed.

4. Log into e-ISuite Site



5. On the Home page under SYSTEM INFORMATION verify the Server Date: includes (Patch 4 to 1.2.4 Applied).



## e-ISuite 1.2.4 Patch 4 Release Summary

Defect ID	Functional Area	Summary
<b>Changes in Patch 4</b>		
5016	Cost Module	Fixes an issue where cost total reflects resource assignment rather than actual costs when running reports without selecting the incident group.
5614	Financial Export	Corrects an issue with adjustment calculations and accounting codes for OF-286 resources in the Financial Export.
<b>Changes in Patch 3</b>		
5599	Time Module	Fixes an issue where time postings appear out of order when posting time for crew members and improves performance when selecting a crew in the Time Module.
<b>Changes from Patch 2</b>		
5593	Reference Data	Fixes an Issue where a blank critical error message displays when entering new Item Codes or Jetports in Reference Data
5600	Check-in/Demob	Fixes an issue where entering a dash as a request number with no numeric suffix causes the resource table not to load and results in a critical error.
5599	Time Module	Improves performance substantially when selecting a crew in the Time Module.

Defect ID	Functional Area	Summary
5594	Custom Reports	Fixes an issue where Custom Reports summarizing costs by Incident were not assigning costs to the correct incidents.
5595	Custom Reports	Fixes an issue where sorting by date fields did not work correctly if the data contained dates from multiple calendar years.
5596	Cost Module	Updated Cost Rates to reflect the new Cost Rates.
<b>Changes from Patch 1</b>		
5592	Cost Accruals	Corrects a calculation issue in the cost accrual detail report.
5591	Custom Reports	Updates two Custom Report Views (RESOURCES – TIME and PERSON – TIME) to correct some problems with inefficient queries.
