



## e-ISuite 1.2.4 Release Notes

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**Date:** April 26, 2018  
**Version:** e-ISuite Version 1.2.4

**Description:** The primary focus of this release is to address several known issues and defects in Release 1.2.3.

### Important Things to Know Prior to Installing e-ISuite Site Version 1.2.4

- **YOU MUST UNINSTALL** all previous versions of e-ISuite Site.  
*Note: See detailed uninstall instructions on the following page*
  - System Requirements
    - Windows 7 Professional, Windows 10 Professional, or Windows 2012 Server
    - No competing http Services (Tomcat6 will provide web services on server machine)
  - Browser Requirements
    - Internet Explorer 11 Officially Supported
    - Google Chrome works well and should be tried if issues are encountered with Internet Explorer 11 or Edge in Windows 10
    - Pop-up Blockers Turned Off
    - Latest Adobe Flash Installed
  - System Administrative privileges **are** required to install the application.  
*Note: To install, download the file and right-click on the installer file and choose either Run as Administrator or Run Elevated (USFS).*

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## **e-ISuite Site Version 1.2.4 Installation Instructions When Previous Version is Installed**

**Step 1:** Copy all the files in the NWCG-BACKUPS folder from C:\ProgramData\e-ISuite to another location such as a USB Drive or External Hard Drive. By default, e-ISuite backups are stored in the following directory: C:\ProgramData\e-ISuite\NWCG-Backups

*Note: Users should copy everything in that directory to a different location (either an external hard drive, a USB drive, or another location on their machine)*

**Step 2:** Uninstall their current version of e-ISuite. The safest way to uninstall e-ISuite is to use the e-ISuite uninstaller in the start menu under Start Menu > All Programs > e-ISuite. Users must run that uninstaller by right-clicking on Uninstall e-ISuite Site and picking either Run Elevated (USFS Users) or Run As Administrator (all other users).

*Note: USFS users should go to the Start Menu>Powerbroker>Powerbroker – Uninstall or Change a Program. A list of programs that can be uninstalled or changed will be displayed and the user should then click on e-ISuite Site to select it and then click on Uninstall. Say Yes to the dialog asking if you are sure you want to uninstall e-ISuite Site and Site will be uninstalled correctly.*

**Step 3:** Users will be required to reboot their systems after they uninstall e-ISuite.

### **Steps 4 is Recommended, but not Required**

**Step 4:** After the system reboots, users need to delete the e-ISuite folder from C:\ProgramData

*Note 1: The C:\ProgramData folder may not be visible if users have their folder settings set to not show hidden files and folders. If it is not visible, users can temporarily change their Folder Settings to show hidden files and folders under the Control Panel > Appearance and Personalization > Folder Options).*

*Note 2: In the future, when e-ISuite versions 1.2.4 and later are uninstalled, it will no longer be necessary to delete the e-ISuite folder from C:\ProgramData because the uninstaller will remove all the files that need to be removed and will leave the C:\ProgramData\e-ISuite\NWCG\_BACKUPS folder on the system, thus ensuring that any database backups do not get deleted during an uninstall. In the future, Users should not remove the C:\ProgramData\e-ISuite\NWCG\_BACKUPS folder because that contains all the database backups from previous installs.*

- **Step 5:** After deleting the e-ISuite folder from C:\ProgramData, users should clear their browser cache before installing e-ISuite Site 1.2.4. Instructions for clearing browser cache in the four most popular browsers can be found at the following link: [Clearing Browser Caches](#). Users may proceed with the installation of e-ISuite Site 1.2.4.

5517	Custom Reports	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A number of minor changes were made to field names in various Custom Report Views to bring greater consistency across the various Report Views.</li> </ul>
5516	Custom Reports	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A number of new fields were added to almost all custom report views.</li> </ul>
5336	Custom Reports	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All Date fields in Custom Reports now return only the date portion of the Date/Time fields used in the database and therefore all date fields will now work correctly when used in aggregate reports.</li> </ul>
5552	Time Module	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>OF-286 Adjustment page now totals correctly if adjustments go to two pages.</li> </ul>
5351	Time Module	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The last invoice for an overhead resource when it is a parent record can now be deleted.</li> </ul>
5158	Time Module	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Prompts have been added to caution users when changing Employment Types for Resources.</li> </ul>
5444	Incidents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The FED agency option has been removed from the Jurisdiction dropdown list on the ADD and EDIT Incident Screens.</li> </ul>

5579	Time Module	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The street office address for the US Forest Service Admin Office for Payment has been updated.</li> </ul>
