
Description: The primary focus of this release is to address several known issues and defects in Release 1.2.5 and update Reference Data tables.

Important Things to Know Prior to Installing e-ISuite Site Version 1.2.6

- **YOU MUST UNINSTALL** all previous versions of e-ISuite Site.
Note: See detailed uninstall instructions on the following page
- System Requirements
 - Windows 7 Professional, Windows 10 Professional, or Windows 2012 Server
 - No competing http Services (Tomcat7 will provide web services on server machine)
- Browser Requirements
 - Internet Explorer 11 Officially Supported
 - Google Chrome works well and should be tried if issues are encountered with Internet Explorer 11 or Edge in Windows 10
 - Pop-up Blockers Turned Off
 - Latest Adobe Flash Installed – Please note when using Google Chrome you will be required to enable Adobe Flash each time you launch the application. To activate the “Get Adobe Flash Player” Icon, you must refresh Chrome. Please see screen capture below that illustrates where to find the Refresh Key in Chrome:



- System administrative privileges **are** required to install the application.
Note: To install, download the file and right-click on the installer file and choose either Run as Administrator or Run Elevated (USFS).

e-ISuite Site Version 1.2.6 Installation Instructions When Previous Version is Installed

Step 1: Uninstall the current version of e-ISuite. The safest way to uninstall e-ISuite is to use the following steps:

- Go to the Start Menu
- Select e-ISuite Site
- Right-click on Uninstall e-ISuite Site
- Select More and choose Open File Location which will bring up a pop-up window
- Right-click on Uninstall e-ISuite Site and choose either Run Elevated (USFS Users) or Run as Administrator (all other users)

Step 2: Users will be required to reboot their systems after uninstalling e-ISuite.

Step 3: Users should clear their browser cache before installing e-ISuite Site 1.2.6. Instructions for clearing browser cache in the four most popular browsers can be found at the following link: [Clearing Browser Caches](#). Users may proceed with the installation of e-ISuite Site 1.2.6.

5676	IAP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> When an Incident Group is selected, the system allows the user to identify whether to include resources from the group or single incident in the IAP Settings.
5680	Reference Data	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Reference Data tables have been reviewed and updated and the AD Rates for 2019 have been added.
5622	Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A validation has been added if there is a time posting that is five days or more into the future. The user will be prompted to select Yes/No before proceeding with the time posting.
5630	Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Hired Date is now validating correctly against the Incident Start Date for contracted, subordinate resources.
5643	Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adjustments that were included in an original invoice can no longer be deleted.
5649	Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An Actual Release Date entered on the OF-286 invoice screen will no longer update the Actual Release Date field in the Common Data area.
5660	Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Special Pay Codes for Casuals on the Post Time screen have been updated so that the word "Casuals" appears at the beginning of the description.
5598	Training Specialist	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Training Assignments List report now prints correctly and does not include an extra blank page.
