Description:

The purpose of Patch 4 is to correct issues found since the deployment of the new user interface. See list below. Additional information is also available on the e-ISuite Webpage:

Important Things to Know Prior to Installing e-ISuite Site 2.0.1 Patch 4

- **Google Chrome is the only supported browser.**
- Only apply this patch to e-ISuite Site Version 2.0.1 Production. All changes from Patch 1-3 are included in Patch 4.
- Backup all databases before applying the patch.
- Close all browser windows and ensure there are no active connections to the e-ISuite Server.
- System Administrative privileges **are** required to install this patch. Users will need to use their agency protocol for installing software.
- The version number will not be updated with this patch. A message stating "(Patch 4 Applied)" will display on the Home Page near the System Version. This will be confirmation that the patch is installed.
- Users ***must*** clear their browser cache after installing e-ISuite Site 2.0.1 Patch 4. Instructions for clearing the browser cache in Chrome can be found here: [Clearing Chrome Browser Cache](#).

Steps for Installation

1. Download the Site 2.0.1 Patch 4 from the Site Downloads page on the e-ISuite Webpage: <https://famid.nwccg.gov/applications/eISuite/general/downloads>
2. Install the patch using your agency protocol for installing software.
3. Reboot your computer.
4. Clear your browser cache. See instructions above on clearing the browser cache in Google Chrome.
5. Log into e-ISuite Site.

On the Home Page next to System Version 2.0.1, verify the following appears: (Patch 4 Applied).

	Functional Area	Summary
Defects fixed in Patch 4		
1	IROC Import	Fixes an issue where selecting Non-Person in the Data Conflicts area resulted in a java lang error.
2	Time	A warning message now appears when changing a resource's Employment Type.
3	Time	If an Employment Type is changed and there are existing time postings, the time postings will now display correctly on the OF-288 after they are edited.
4	Time	Fixes an issue where editing a Post Start Time Only posting was setting the number of hours to null and causing Time Reports not to run.
5	Time	Fixes an issue where hitting the Enter key multiple times on the post time screen resulted in duplicate postings.
6	User Accounts	The application will now accept user accounts with a minimum of two characters.
