Description:

****Important Things to Know Prior to Installing e-ISuite Site 2.0.1 Patch 6****

- **Google Chrome is the only supported browser.**
- Only apply this patch to e-ISuite Site Version 2.0.1 Production. All changes from Patch 1-5 are included in Patch 6.
- Backup all databases before applying the patch.
- Close all browser windows and ensure there are no active connections to the e-ISuite Server.
- System Administrative privileges **are** required to install this patch. Users will need to use their agency protocol for installing software.
- The version number will not be updated with this patch. A message stating "(Patch 6 Applied)" will display on the Home Page near the System Version. This will be confirmation that the patch is installed.
- Users ***must*** clear their browser cache after installing e-ISuite Site 2.0.1 Patch 6. Instructions for clearing the browser cache in Chrome can be found here: [Clearing Chrome Browser Cache](#).

Steps for Installation

1. *Download the Site 2.0.1 Patch 6 from the Site Downloads page on the e-ISuite Webpage: <https://famit.nwcg.gov/applications/eISuite/general/downloads>*
2. *Install the patch using your agency protocol for installing software.*
3. *Reboot your computer.*
4. *Clear your browser cache. See instructions above on clearing the browser cache in Google Chrome.*
5. *Log into e-ISuite Site.*
