Version: e-ISuite Version 2.1.1

Description: The primary focus of this release is to fix defects found in Version 2.1.0 and address an Apache Log4j security vulnerability.

e-ISuite Enterprise Version 2.1.1 (No Installation Necessary)

The e-ISuite Enterprise System will continue to be hosted on the USFS Fire and Aviation Management National Enterprise Support System (NESS) General Support System (GSS) at the National Information Technology Center (NITC) in Kansas City, MO.

Important Things to Know Prior to Installing e-ISuite Site 2.1.1

- System Requirements
 - Windows 7 Professional, Windows 10 Professional, or Windows 2012/2016 Server
 - No competing http Services (Tomcat9 will provide web services on server machine)
 - Optimal screen resolution is 1366 x 768
- Browser Requirements
 - **Google Chrome** is the preferred browser.
 - Pop-up Blockers Turned Off
- System administrative privileges **are** required to install the application.
Note: Users will need to follow their agency protocol for installing software.

Site 2.1.1 Installation Instructions

Step 1: YOU MUST UNINSTALL all previous versions of e-ISuite Site. Follow your agency protocol for uninstalling software.

Step 2: Users will be required to reboot their systems after uninstalling e-ISuite.

Step 3: Users must clear their browser cache before installing e-ISuite Site 2.1.1. Instructions for clearing the browser cache in Google Chrome can be found at the following link: [Clearing Chrome Browser Cache](#).

Step 4: Users may now proceed with the installation of e-ISuite Site 2.1.1. Follow your agency protocol for installing software.

Version 2.1.1 Release Summary

Functional Area	Summary
Cost	Fixes an issue where data was not displaying on the Aircraft Detail Report. Note: This has been fixed in Enterprise but has not been fixed in the Site version. The fix for Site will be included in the next release.
Cost	Fixes an issue where the Agency could not be edited for a Cost Group.
Financial Export	Fixes an issue where the system was allowing multiple Financial Exports to be created for the same day.
General	Fixes were implemented throughout the application to prevent duplicate data if a button is Double-Clicked or the Enter Key or Space Bar is pressed more than once.
General	The Apache Log4j security vulnerability was addressed.
IAP	The Operational Period field has been limited to 20 characters to prevent wrapping and altering the format of other headers on IAP forms.
IAP	Fixes an issue where the rows were numbered incorrectly, and the Re-Order function wasn't working after manually adding resources and frequencies to the ICS-204 and ICS-205 forms.
IAP	Data is now displaying correctly when adding resources to branches on the ICS-203 Form.
Incident Groups	When adding users to an incident group in Enterprise, the user account will automatically be added to all incidents within the group.
Plans Reports	Resources entered on the Other Costs tab in the Cost Module will no longer be included on the ICS-209 report.
Time	The Treat Enter as Tab function is now working on the Crew Post and Adjustments screen.
Time	The date range for previous original OF-288 and OF-286 invoices will now display invoices in the Remarks field.
Time	Fixes an issue where the Stop Time was not displaying on the OF-288 if it was added after the Post Start Time Only function was used.
Time	Incident names that are over 19 characters will now print correctly on OF-288 and OF-286 invoices.

Functional Area	Summary
Time	Fixes an issue where time postings on the Post Time Screen were not displaying as locked after generating an original OF-288/OF-286 invoice.
Time	The system will now prevent time postings to different Employment Types on the same day.
Training Specialist	Training Specialist forms are no longer blank if a resource does not have an Agency defined.
