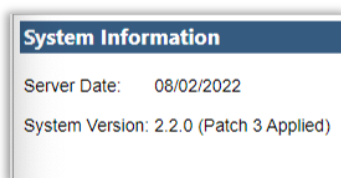
****Important Things to Know Prior to Installing e-ISuite Site 2.2.0 Patch 3****

- Google Chrome is the preferred browser.
- Only apply this patch to e-ISuite Site Version 2.2.0 Production. This patch contains all fixes addressed in Patches 1-2 as well as those listed below.
- Backup all databases before applying the patch.
- Close all browser windows and ensure there are no active connections to the e-ISuite Server.
- System Administrative privileges **are** required to install this patch. Users will need to follow their agency protocol for installing software.
- The version number will not be updated with this patch. A message stating "(Patch 3 Applied)" will display on the Home Page near the System Version. This will be confirmation that the patch is installed.
- Users **must** clear their browser cache after installing e-ISuite Site 2.2.0 Patch 3. Instructions for clearing the browser cache in Chrome can be found here: [Clearing Chrome Browser Cache](#).

Steps for Installation

1. Download the Site 2.2.0 Patch 3 from the Site Downloads page on the e-ISuite Webpage: <https://famit.nwccg.gov/applications/eISuite/general/downloads>
2. Install the patch using your agency protocol for installing software.
3. Reboot your computer.
4. Clear your browser cache. See instructions above on clearing the browser cache in Google Chrome.
5. Log into e-ISuite Site.

Functional Area	Summary
Check-In	The email address field will now accept additional special characters including an underscore.
Check-In	Quick Stats have been updated to reflect the Item Code changes made in the 2.2.0 release.
Plans Reports	<p>The following reports were updated to allow more characters to display in the Request Number field:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All Resources Report • Qualifications Report • Strike/Team Task Force Report • Tentative Release Poster • Actual Demob Report
Cost	Fixes an issue where the system was not retaining changes to daily cost records with a cost level of (F) Flowed-Down from Actual.
Cost	The flow-down feature will now flow-down changes to subsequent records, regardless of cost level.
Cost	Fixes an issue where the system was not calculating the cost correctly when an OF-286 resource has the half rate box checked on primary mileage with guarantee and primary daily for the same day.
IAP	<p>The system will now automatically correct duplicate row numbers on the following forms so that the re-order function will work properly:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ICS-203 Blocks 3-8 • ICS-204 Blocks 4, 5 and 8 • ICS-205 Block 4 • ICS-206 Blocks 3-7 • ICS-220 Blocks 10 and 12
Time	The system will now prevent a start time of 2400, which was causing issues when using the post start time only feature.
