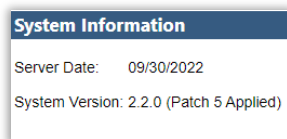
Important Things to Know Prior to Installing e-ISuite Site 2.2.0 Patch 5

- Google Chrome is the preferred browser.
- Only apply this patch to e-ISuite Site Version 2.2.0 Production. This patch contains all fixes addressed in Patches 1-4 as well as those listed below.
- Backup all databases before applying the patch.
- Close all browser windows and ensure there are no active connections to the e-ISuite Server.
- System Administrative privileges **are** required to install this patch. Users will need to follow their agency protocol for installing software.
- The version number will not be updated with this patch. A message stating "(Patch 5 Applied)" will display on the Home Page near the System Version. This will be confirmation that the patch is installed.
- Users **must** clear their browser cache after installing e-ISuite Site 2.2.0 Patch 5. Instructions for clearing the browser cache in Chrome can be found here: [Clearing Chrome Browser Cache](#).

Steps for Installation

1. Download the Site 2.2.0 Patch 5 from the Site Downloads page on the e-ISuite Webpage: <https://famit.nwccg.gov/applications/eISuite/general/downloads>
2. Install the patch using your agency protocol for installing software.
3. Reboot your computer.
4. Clear your browser cache. See instructions above on clearing the browser cache in Google Chrome.
5. Log into e-ISuite Site.

e-ISuite 2.2.0 Patch 5 Release Summary

Functional Area	Summary
Cost	Fixes an issue where blank errors were occurring when running cost.
Cost	Added the ability to delete multiple daily cost records at the same time.
Financial Export	Fixes an issue where time postings on the OF-286 Invoice were causing an error when running the Financial Export.
IAP	Plan Name field length has been updated to accept 50 characters to match the Incident Name field.
Manage Site Database	Implemented fixes to prevent multi-clicking fields in the Database Management area.
Time	Fixes an issue where partial payment amounts were not displaying correctly on the OF-286 Invoice.
Time	Fixes an issue where mileage rates were being rounded on the post time screen.
Time	Fixes an issue where the OF-286 Invoice was not displaying three decimal places for mileage rates.
